#### Infant Mental Health Endorsement<sup>®</sup> Steps to Apply

The Infant Mental Health Endorsement<sup>®</sup> is for providers who live in Virginia and work with children birth to 36 months. Please review the following chart by looking at the education and work requirements for each of the 4 categories of Endorsement<sup>®</sup> and find the category that most closely aligns with your education and work experience. Minimum of 2 years of paid work experience with infants birth-36 mos. If no work experience, a CDA credential, Associate's, Bachelor's, Master's, and/or Doctorate degree. Volunteer experience may meet this criterion if it was a supervised experience with infants/toddlers birth-36 months and their families, and included specialized training.	Minimum of 2 years of paid, post-Bachelor's, professional work experience providing prevention and/or early intervention services that promote infant mental health. Applicant has served a minimum of 10 families where the target of services is an infant/toddler (birth - 36 mos.) or the supervision of staff who provide services to infants/toddlers (birth-36 months) and their families. A primary focus of the services provided is the social-emotional needs of the infant/toddler; and Services focus on the promotion of the relationships surrounding the infant/toddler.	Minimum of 2 years of post-graduate, supervised paid work experience providing culturally sensitive, relationship-focused, infant mental health services. Specialized work experience must be with both the infant/toddler (birth-36 mos.) and his/her biological, foster, or adoptive parent(s) or guardian(s) on behalf of the parent-infant relationship. Infant mental health services include parent-infant/child relationship-based therapies and practices and early relationship assessment and can include concrete assistance, advocacy, emotional support, and developmental guidance. These therapies and practices are intended to explicitly address issues related to attachment, separation, trauma, and unresolved grief and losses as they affect the attachment relations, development, behavior, and care of the child. The unresolved losses might be from adverse childhood experiences that occurred during the caregivers' own early childhood or may be more recent for the child. Strong feelings, such as grief and loss. could also be associated with diagnosis or manifestations of a chronic illness, delay, or disability.	IV-C Meets specialized work experience criteria as specified for prevention and/or early intervention services that promote infant mental health. Applicant has served a minimum of 10 families or supervised staff where the target of services is an infant/toddler (birth-36 mos.) and has 3 years of post-graduate experience providing IMH reflective supervision /consultation (RS/C). Also required are leadership activities at the regional or state	IV-P Minimum 3 years of post- graduate experience as a leader in policy and/or program administration related to the promotion of early childhood mental health principles and practices in the context of family and other caregiving relationships across systems. Also required are leadership activities at the regional or state level. ### **Steps to Apply**

- 1. **Obtain** your Supervisor's approval to pursue your IMH Endorsement.
- 2. **Print** this document so you have it available with you at your computer to refer to for the remaining steps.
- 3. **Review** the <u>Endorsement for Culturally Sensitive, Relationship-Focused Practice Promoting Infant</u> <u>Mental Health Competency Guidelines</u> for more detailed information for each category.
- 4. **Update** your resume so it is ready to upload with your application.
- 5. Join the Virginia Association for Infant Mental Health (VAIMH). The Endorsement<sup>®</sup> requires that you are a member of your state's Association for Infant Mental Health for both your <u>initial</u> Endorsement and the <u>renewal</u> of your Endorsement once it is received. VAIMH membership is an annual membership cycle due each January covering January 1<sup>st</sup> December 31<sup>st</sup>.
